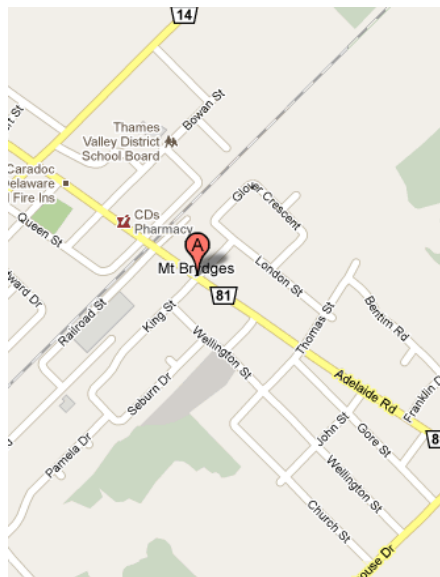


SOUTHWEST MIDDLESEX HEALTH CENTRE

DEMOGRAPHICS

- Located ~25km from the centre of London
- The centre provides care to patients in surrounding communities of Mount Brydges, Delaware, Komoka, and the First Nations communities of Oneida, Muncey, and Chippewa
- Patients of SWMHC who require hospitalization are admitted to Strathroy Middlesex General Hospital

PRACTICE EXPERIENCE

- Southwest Middlesex Health Centre (SWMHC) is a multidisciplinary clinic which provides services of a Social Worker, Dietician, Physiotherapy, Dental services, and a community Pharmacy
- The clinic is equipped with casting, x-ray, laboratory, and urgent care treatment facilities
- Patients are seen in the office, at Strathroy Middlesex General Hospital, at a nearby nursing home in Komoka, and a local rest home
- Patient profile includes: adult medicine, geriatrics, obstetrics/gynecology, counseling/psychology, pediatrics/well-baby care

TEACHING

- 8 residents per 16 week block
- There is a strong rural "hands-on" and culturally sensitive flavor to learning opportunities
- 4 staff physicians provide coverage
- We provide home call for the nursing homes, approximately 1/8
- Residents do approximately 25-30 hours/month in Strathroy
- Educational sessions every Wednesday a.m.
